 with Clergy and lay participation, always with the approval of both Presbyteries and
 in consultation with both Partnership Committees.
- We will share our life experiences mutually and with others.
- Church-to-Church partnerships will be sought through the discernment of local Sessions and with the approval of both Presbyteries.
- Our Partnership will be in effect for five (5) years beginning on this day, February 15, 2015. One or either of the Presbyteries may elect to end the Partnership after informative discussion. At the end of five years we will evaluate the Partnership to determine if it should continue.

We ask God to guide us in this continuing Partnership.
